On behalf of our Members and Club Management, welcome to Colorado Golf Club. To ensure a most memorable experience during your visit, please join us in observing our traditions. In order to ensure the very best golf experience possible for all, please take a moment to review the regulations observed by the Colorado Golf Club membership. These simple guidelines will affect proper etiquette, pace of play and the enjoyment of the day for all. The professional staff of Colorado Golf Club is completely dedicated to delivering the highest level of personalized service to all members and guests.

Dress Code:

Proper golf attire is required of Members and Guests at all times while on Colorado Golf Club property.

Denim, Cargo shorts or pants, running or tennis shorts are not permitted at any time.

- ✓ Men & Boys – Must wear appropriate golf shirts that are tucked in, golf trousers or Bermuda length shorts.
- ✓ Women & Girls – Sleeveless blouses are permitted as are Bermuda length shorts and skirts, and golf slacks or culottes.
- ✓ All Players – Must wear spike-less, soft spike, or rubber soled shoes.
- ✓ All Players – Men and boys are required to remove their caps when they enter the Clubhouse. Caps are acceptable on the outside patio. Ladies may wear caps or visors in the Clubhouse.

Cell Phones/Mobile Devices:

Colorado Golf Club allows limited use of your mobile device. Texting and emailing are allowed on property without being intrusive to others. Phone calls can **ONLY** be made in your vehicle, the business office (located in the west wing of the clubhouse) or in the locker bays in the locker-rooms.

Gratuities:

Colorado Golf Club is a non-tipping club with the exception of the locker room staff and recommended tip for caddie services.

Locker Room:

The locker room is available for all guests for daily use. Locker room staff will be happy to provide a guest locker at no charge. Unaccompanied guest wishing to eat at the club prior to or after a round are welcome in the Members Grill. The Men's Grill in the locker room area is reserved for members and accompanied guests only. Thank you.

Caddie Policy:

A forecaddie is required for unaccompanied guests or in groups where there are more guests than members. Caddies must be paid in cash or charged to a member account. Our Caddie Master Mike Engler will visit with you prior to your round to introduce you to your caddie and answer any questions. Caddie fees range from \$40.00 to \$100.00 per player inclusive of gratuity, depending on if you have a forecaddie or carry caddie.

Playing Rules:

It is required that all guests check in at the Golf Shop prior to utilizing the golf facilities. It is expected that the pace of play guidelines be followed with **4 hours 30 minutes for 18 holes of golf being expected**. Please play the appropriate set of tees for your ability. Our Professional staff will be monitoring pace of play and communicating to you how you are doing. Please respect them at all times.

Parking:

Members and guests will have the option to use valet services or self-park.
